#### **Traffic Patterns**

<u>Elementary Parking Lot</u> – The drop/off pick up loop can be accessed from 43<sup>rd</sup> Street. Students in Kindergarten, 3<sup>rd</sup>, & 4<sup>th</sup> grades are to be dropped off at the sidewalk near the playground area. Teachers will bring students to this area for pick up at the end of the day. Students in 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup> grades are to be dropped off at the sidewalk behind the elementary building. Teachers will bring students to this area for pick up at the end of the day. Please remember to pull forward in line as far as possible to pick up and drop off children to keep the line moving.

Please do not park in or block the handicap parking spots!

<sup>\*</sup>Students must wear approved dress code for picture day.

Secondary School and Fine Arts Parking Lot - The lane along the sidewalk in front of and between the secondary and fine arts buildings is for ACTIVE LOADING AND UNLOADING ONLY - there is no parking along the curbs at ANY TIME. PARENTS, please DO NOT wait in parking spots in front of the high school building when dropping off students in the morning. Student drivers have a difficult time finding parking spots and getting into school before the morning bell rings. Parents who need to come into the office may park in the guest or regular parking spaces. Your cooperation is appreciated. High School students who drive cars to school must park in front of the secondary building. Students are not allowed to park in the first 2 rows in front of the high school building.

### **Morning Snack**

Each preschooler will need a morning snack and a kid-size reusable water bottle every day.

#### Lunch

If your preschooler will be staying all day, please be sure to pack a lunch with all necessary items included (spoon, fork, freezer pack, etc.). Hot lunch is NOT available for preschoolers.

#### **Dress Code**

Preschool students may wear play clothes (that can get dirty) to school. Items can be purchased from any store. Students may wear BCS items, but it is not required. Students must wear tennis shoes, sneakers, or athletic shoes – Velcro is highly encouraged since laces can get caught on the equipment. NO sandals, slip-ons, crocs, boots, light-up, noise-making or wheeled shoes, etc. are allowed.

#### **Aftercare**

BCS Main Campus Panther Care is available after full days that school is in session from 3:00 pm - 5:30 pm. Panther Care costs \$10 per day for attendance and it will be billed monthly to your FACTS account. For a preschooler to attend Panther Care, we request parents fill out an Intent to Attend form (below) and return it to your child's teacher or to the Elementary front office. Students that have not been picked up from preschool by the 2:45 pm deadline will be considered an attendee of Panther Care and will be charged the daily fee of \$10.

Preschool students will be transported by a BCS school bus to the main campus where they will then be received by the BCS Panther Care staff in the Elementary auditorium. For the safety of all students, pick-up will not be an option while students are departing the bus.

Children may be picked up by pre-authorized adults on your pick-up list in FACTS, after 3:00 and before 5:30. If you arrive early at the main campus, you are welcome to check in at the Elementary office.

### **Elementary School Information: Grades K-5**

#### K-5th Grade Dress Code

Students must wear official BCS school logo shirts or t-shirts purchased from Manatee Apparel or Lands' End. A variety of boys' and girls' t-shirts, polos, blouses, and other styles will be available in a variety of colors and price points. BCS shirts from prior years can also be worn. You may also visit our Panther Den Store on our BCS campus (located in the high school building) to find gently used BCS uniforms & T-shirts, and some new apparel.

Pants: Pants, jeans, and athletic pants in your choice of color/style--not tight, form-fitting, or

excessively small or large. Can be from any store. Yoga-style or legging style pants are not permitted unless worn under a dress, skirt, or shorts of appropriate mid-thigh

length.

Shorts/Skorts/Skirts: Knee-length loose-fitting soccer or basketball shorts are the only athletic shorts that

can be worn by boys and girls. No other type of gym short is permitted. Gym pants, such as those found in warm-up suits or track suits can be worn if they are not form fitting. Form fitting, spandex, or Soffe/cheer style gym shorts are not permitted unless

worn under a skirt, skort, shorts or dress of appropriate mid-thigh length.

Girls are asked to wear shorts under dresses and skirts. Any style short can be worn under a dress or skirt if the dress or skirt meets the dress code length requirement and

the shorts do not show. This is to preserve modesty.

Dresses: Dresses with the Bradenton Christian School logo purchased from Lands End.

Shoes: Tennis shoes/sneakers/athletic shoes that lace up and tie, close with Velcro, or have

fitted elastic. Boots, light-up, noisemaking, wheeled, wedge or "high-heel" style

sneakers are not allowed.

Sweaters/Sweatshirts/ Can be any style from any store. Logos, pictures, and prints are allowed. These items

Coats/Jackets: must be worn over a BCS logo shirt or dress.

### **After School Program**

Panther Care is an extended care program provided by BCS for BCS Elementary students. It is available after full days that school is in session and begins at 3:15 pm and ends at 5:30 pm. Children may be picked up by any of the pre-authorized adults on your pick-up list in FACTS. Panther Care costs \$10 per student, per daily attendance and is billed monthly to your FACTS account.

Should you decide to use our Panther Care program, please fill out the Intent to Attend form (below) and send it in to your child's teacher or the Elementary front office.

Panther Care Flexible Schedule:

We begin our afternoon with silent homework time. Students are encouraged to keep a book to read in their backpacks for when they do not have homework. Kindergarten is engaged in story circle during this time.

After homework time, we go outside for free play. This is also an opportunity for children to eat a snack they have brought from home - snacks are not provided by Panther Care.

Lastly, we have various inside activities such as prayer time, board games, crafts, movies, and computer lab. Should you have a change in plans regarding your child's attendance any certain day, please communicate that with their teacher. Teachers will drop off students who are not picked up from the car line to Panther Care at 3:15 pm.

### **Summer Reading Assignments**

Middle School and High School summer reading assignments are listed on our website under the Academics tab, then Secondary.

### **Secondary School Textbooks**

All students must have an ESV Bible that they will use through the 12<sup>th</sup> grade.

**Grades 6-8:** All textbook requirements will be provided on the first day of school - <u>with the exception of 8th Grade Spanish I.</u> If you are an 8th grader taking Spanish I, you will be assessed a \$68 fee on your FACTS account and we will provide your textbook, online textbook and workbook.

**Grade 9:** All textbook requirements will be provided on the first day of school. You will be assessed a one-time fee of \$200, which will cover textbook online codes, workbooks & novels.

**Grades 10-12:** Students are responsible for purchasing their own textbooks and should have all of their textbooks by the first day of school. The textbook checklist is on our website under Academics, then Secondary. All materials for English\* (novels, vocab & grammar workbooks) will be provided by the school and a charge will be assessed to your account. **\*Exception:** if you are taking AP English (Lang. or Lit.), you are responsible for purchasing the AP English textbook.

You will notice several classes have fees instead of textbooks. The fees include a classroom book and online access. Please refer to the textbook checklist on our website.

**BNS** Direct is our textbook distributor and may be accessed through our BCS website by clicking Academics, Secondary, Textbook List/Bookstore and then the Online Bookstore icon. In order to guarantee that you are buying the correct books and editions that are required, please purchase your books in this way. The bookstore will open July 12 and **free shipping** will be offered July 18-24 on all orders over \$99.

### 9th Grade Laptop Requirement

BCS will be purchasing laptops through a technology fee of \$650 that will be assessed to each 9<sup>th</sup> grade student's FACTS account. This allows BCS to partner with parents in the maintenance and management of your device. This also allows the device to travel between home and school.

#### **Dress Code**

Uniforms can be ordered through Manatee Apparel at 1130 9<sup>th</sup> Street W., Bradenton, 941-746-6353. We will be selling used BCS polo's, hoodies and spirit shirts in Wicher's Auditorium from 9:00am – 1:00pm on July 20<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup>, and 25<sup>th</sup>. Please bring CASH or CHECK only!

#### **All 6th Graders**

All 6<sup>th</sup> grade students will be offered a Scoliosis screening. More information and permission forms will be sent in the fall.

#### **All 7th Graders**

The Tdap (Tetanus-Diphtheria-Pertussis) Vaccine is required for 7th grade entry, as well as the 2nd Varicella (chickenpox) Vaccine.

#### **Calculators**

Please note the following are suggested calculators for BCS math classes: **Texas Instruments TI-30X, Texas Instruments TI-30XIIS, Texas Instruments TI-84, Texas Instruments TI-83.** Some graphing and scientific calculators will not be allowed because of their ability to manipulate algebraic symbols. The following are <u>not</u> acceptable calculators: TI-92, TI-89, TI Voyager, TI Multiview, Casio Natural Display and Sharp Write View Display. ### After School Study Hall for MS and HS

An updated e-mail will be sent if any changes occur. Please review the policies and instructions below for ordering lunches.

#### **Ordering Lunches through RenWeb/FACTS SIS**

- Log into your parent RenWeb/FACTS SIS Log In account the district code is BRAD-FL.
- Go to Student section on the left hand side of the screen and click Lunch
- You will see a calendar for the current week. Above the calendar, click on create web order.
- Click on the box with your child's name that you want to order lunch for. The order form is listed by day and date. You can now place your lunch order/s on the scroll down list. All of your students will show up in order of grade level on the scroll down list just keep scrolling to get to the end of the month to see your next child.
- Once you have finished all orders for your student(s), scroll to the bottom and click Order Items. Fill in your
  credit/debit card (fee will apply) or bank account information. Follow the prompts to complete the payment,
  make sure you are scrolling to the bottom of the pages to complete the steps for payment processing.
- Please do not pay lunch and tuition together in the same payment as the system cannot recognize them separately. The food order will not be placed.
- Orders may be placed weekly or monthly and are due by Thursday at 8:00 am for the following week's lunches.
- To confirm payment has been made, return to the week or month calendar at a glance and see if the items ordered are in blue (paid) or in red (unpaid). If they are in red, please contact Angela Hamilton at 792-5454, ext. 141 or e-mail ahamilton@bcspanthers.org.

#### **Lunch Refunds**

- Refunds for lunches WILL NOT be issued for sick days, class parties or field trips, as food has already been
  ordered and paid for. Look for field trips, class parties and special events to be posted on the lunch
  ordering menu before placing the order.
- A refund may be requested for state tournament game days or when school is closed due to inclement weather.

#### **Panther Credit**

Panther Credit may be purchased on RenWeb in the amount of \$5, \$10, or \$20 and will allow middle/high students to purchase hot food, drinks, and snacks.

For Elementary Students: Panther Credit is highly recommended for all students to cover the cost in the event your student forgets their lunch. There is no extra hot food/drinks or snacks to buy in Elementary.

For Middle & High School Students: Panther Credit is highly recommended for all students to cover the cost of purchasing extra hot food/drinks and snacks, or in the event your student forgets their lunch.

### **No Lunch Policy**

If a student is without a lunch the school will provide:

Elementary: PB & J Uncrustable, applesauce, and water (if an allergy a lunchable will be provided)

Middle/High: PB & J Uncrustable, chips, and water

A fee of \$6.00 will be charged to your account. Some exceptions may apply.

### **Health Room Policy and Procedures**

#### **Medication Policy**

Prescription medication may only be dispensed from its original container and accompanied by a physician's prescription and written parental permission. *If your child needs an over-the-counter medication, the student MUST have a physician's prescription and written parental permission as well.* All medication must be delivered to the health room by the student's parent, legal guardian or a previously designated adult. It is against school policy for a student to carry ANY medication on their person without prior approval. All medication must be maintained in the Health Room. Medication needed on field trips is also covered by this policy and must be administered by an individual designated by the principal.

#### For your child's safety please remember:

- Absolutely no medication will be given without written parental permission.
- School health room personnel may not administer the first dose of any medication. (Student should be monitored by the parent at home for possible side effects following initial dose).
- School health room personnel are legally required to administer only medications with FDA approval.
- All PRESCRIPTION medication must be administered as labeled and OTC medications may not exceed package directions.
- ALL MEDICATION MUST BE IN THE ORIGINAL CONTAINER. No medication will be given from zip-lock bags or envelopes.
- If your child forgets to take a morning dose of medication, school health room personnel are not allowed to give that dose at school. Parents may come to the Health Room to give the missed dose.
- Students with medication prescribed by a health care provider contained in the original packaging and appropriately labeled may carry these medications, may self-monitor and may self-administer these medications only if we have permission from the prescribing doctor and the parent/legal guardian. If there is sufficient evidence that unsupervised self-monitoring or self-medicating would seriously jeopardize the safety of the student or others, the school may refuse the student to carry his/her medication.

#### **Contacting Parents**

If your child comes to the Health Room and needs to go home, we must contact a parent or legal guardian. We cannot send a student home with anyone until a parent has been notified. <u>This is why it is so very important that we have your current contact information of how to contact you at all times.</u> If your child has an emergency situation or needs immediate care that cannot be provided at school, those contacts you list on the Health Card will be called, IF we cannot reach a parent first. If this information should change, please notify your school health room personnel immediately. Please understand that this is for your child's protection.

# **Want to Earn Money toward your Tuition?**

### Join the TRIP Program (Tuition Reduction Incentive Program)

**Purpose -** The Tuition Reduction Incentive Program (TRIP) is an opportunity for the families of Bradenton Christian School to reduce their tuition. Through TRIP, gift cards can be purchased from participating vendors with a rebate. These cards are sold at face value to families who participate in the program and the rebate is issued in the form of tuition credit on a monthly basis.

**General Information and Policies -** Family and friends may participate and contribute to your TRIP account by filling out the appropriate section of the registration form. Parents looking to the future and planning for Christian education of their young children at BCS can also participate. These families will be assigned an account number. The monies earned will be held by BCS and will be credited as a tuition payment when their child is enrolled as a student. This is a non-interest bearing account.

- The gift cards are the same as cash. Neither BCS nor TRIP will accept responsibility for lost or misplaced cards.
- In no way does BCS or the TRIP program endorse the stores listed on the order form. You must make your own decisions
  concerning your purchases.
- Each store has their own policy on change back from cards. Review store policies before paying for your purchase.
- TRIP is being offered to promote the education of BCS; therefore, the money collected on your account will only be paid
  to BCS for tuition reduction. If your student no longer attends BCS, the monies held under your family account number will
  be put into the general tuition assistance fund upon your departure.

**Registration** - Anyone establishing a TRIP account must be familiar with the policies, submit a registration form and set up a PrestoPay account.

**Payment** - All orders will be paid through PrestoPay. Payment is due at time of order.

Rebates - The percentage earned on each participating family's account will be held by TRIP and credited to your tuition account on a monthly basis. If your tuition is paid in full for that year, it will be credited to the next year's balance. Any discrepancies must be brought to the attention of the school within 2 weeks of the statement date. BCS will credit your account 80% of the total rebate and will retain 20% for the general tuition assistance fund and administrative TRIP cost. Rebates may be used for tuition only. Students that withdraw early may use rebates toward their tuition balance but no reimbursement will be issued other than tuition payment.

**Let's Get Started!** - Complete the TRIP registration form and submit to the TRIP coordinator, Middle School Assistant. After completing this form you will receive an email with your username and password.

**Set-Up PrestoPay Account** – Once you have received your username and password, log on to <a href="https://www.ShopWithScrip.com">www.ShopWithScrip.com</a>, click on the PrestoPay link in the left navigation bar, and complete the bank account information. Within 2-3 business days, Great Lakes Scrip Center will deposit two small amounts into your bank account. Enter these amounts in your PrestoPay registration to verify the account. You will receive an email with an approval code which you will submit to the TRIP coordinator. The TRIP coordinator will notify you by email upon activation of your account.

**Shop!** - Visit <u>www.Shopwithscrip.com</u>, to choose your gift cards, place your orders, and view your account. Orders may be placed on-line 24/7, however, orders will be processed every Tuesday at 9:00 a.m. with delivery on Thursday. You will receive an email when orders have been filled and are ready for pick-up in the Middle School Office. ScripNow and reloadable cards are always a quick, convenient option too!
